Wemms Statement of Ethos

Wemms is a small, independent school that provide the unique and the extraordinary with a place to breathe easy, learn to respect who they are and the talents they have been born with. This school is for capable people, who have found it impossible to thrive in a formal mainstream environment.

The Key principles that underpin our vison are that all young people are entitled to a fulfilling education that develops their gifts and enables them to overcome their challenges. We expect to provide a holistic education that sees our students develop socially, morally and academically. Believing that education needs to catalyse all aspects of human growth, we seek to help the student understand their own unique learning style and gain the resilience to persevere when facing adversity.

We aim to offer our students the chance to engage in a full curriculum encompassing Maths, Stats, Triple Science, English Language and Literature, Humanities and MFL to exam standard. In addition, we offer subjects to feed the soul- music, art, drama, cooking, construction skills, supported by PE, PSHE, Citizenship and current affairs, and public speaking.

Wemms vision is that our students should graduate from Wemms Education Centre as well rounded, confident citizens of 21st Century Britain, with a strong commitment to society and to be the best human they are capable of being. Our students know that not everyone is a grade A academic in every aspect of the curriculum, but they also know that everyone can be a grade A human being.

Wemms strives to ensure its students have resilience, compassion, empathy, integrity, determination and grit. We expect them to be able to live independently, follow the career path of their choice and be guided by their own quiet sense of what is right and wrong.
